WATER ORDERS

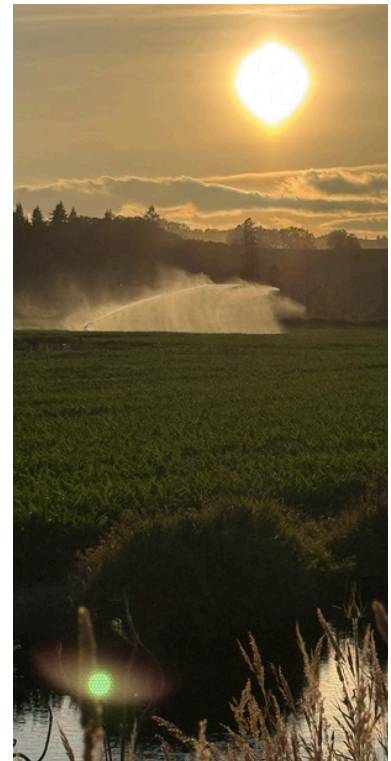
During Regular and Extended Irrigation Season ALL water users must order water prior to using regardless of the amount being used.

The water order can be taken for a 7 day duration. Pipeline users need to order 24 hours and river users 48 hours PRIOR TO USING. If you are wanting water during the weekend, you must call BEFORE 12 pm the Thursday or Friday prior to watering. In the event of a scheduled shutdown, we attempt to notify those who have ordered water.

REMINDER:

Although cannabis has been legalized in Oregon. It is still illegal as far as the Federal Government is concerned. The Controlled Substance Act of 1970 (CSA) and its implementing regulations prohibit the cultivation of marijuana, as defined at subsection 102(16) of the CSA (codified at 21 U.S. C. 802(16))¹. Reclamation's obligation as a Federal Agency to uphold Federal law prohibits it from approving the use of Reclamation water or facilities to facilitate activities prohibited by the CSA. This NO LONGER includes Industrial Hemp.

Are you considering selling?

TVID accounts are not automatically updated at the sale of your property to reflect new ownership of the assessed water acreage.



TVID requires a Certificate of Sale form to be filled out by the seller and the buyer within 30 days of new ownership.

Late Season Water

Regular irrigation season will end September 30th. Meters will be read at this time. Be sure to have the area around your box free of debris. If you would like to use water in October, or October and November, an **Extended Irrigation Season Application must be completed and returned along with the appropriate payment to our office by the September 20th deadline.** This process applies to both pipeline and river users. (Form Included or available at TVID.org/forms-policies)

IMPORTANT: All turnouts which have not submitted an Extended Irrigation Season Application by September 20th will be scheduled to be shut off and winterized for the season on October 1st. There is a \$100 charge to restore service to turnouts which have been shut off for the season.

PUBLIC NOTICE OF ELECTION

August 2026
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

The Director positions from Districts 3 and 4 currently held by Joe Finegan and Paul Coussens, respectively, will be up for election on November 10th, 2026.

If someone wishes to run for District 3 or District 4, the following will apply:

How to qualify and nominate a candidate:

A Director must be a resident of Oregon and an owner, or a shareholder of a corporate owner, of land within the subdivision of the district. Nominations may be made by petition (available in the office) signed by a least 10 electors in the subdivision who are qualified to vote for the director nominated by them, or at an assembly of not less than 25 electors and filed with the secretary of the Board at least 35 days before the election. If, after the nomination filing deadline, there is only one qualified candidate, it is not necessary to hold an election.

Who may vote:

An elector or voter in the district must have the following qualifications:

- (1) Be 18 years of age or older.
- (2) Must own or be purchasing under contract land situated within the district and subject to the charges or assessments of the district. There is no longer any minimum acreage requirement.
- (3) Need not reside in the district or in the state. What about multiple ownership's: Where ownership is in estates by the entirety, only one vote shall be allowed on behalf of all the owners under multiple ownership. Any corporation shall be entitled to vote as a single landowner through any officer or agent duly authorized in writing under the seal of the corporation.

Weighted Voting:

The weighted voting system is based on the number of acres you own. One vote may be cast for up to 40 acres. 2 votes for 41 to 160 acres and 3 votes for 161 acres on up.

What sub-division are you in:

The district is divided into five sub-districts or divisions. There is a map of the district showing the divisions on the back.

Vote by Mail:

The Board of Directors has declared this to be a mail-in ballot election (if necessary).

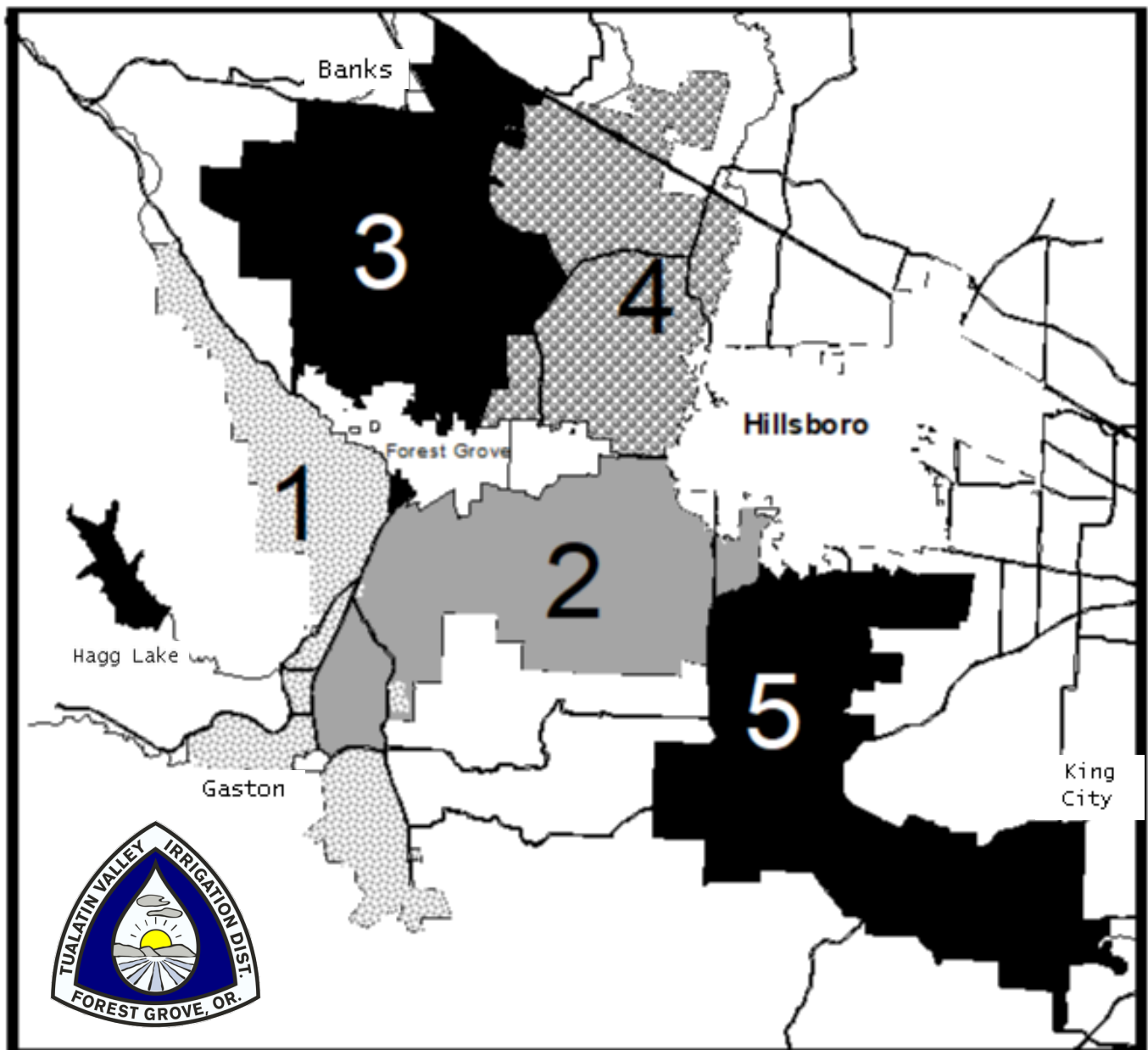


TUALATIN VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT

Subscription for Extended Irrigation Season

Application must be filed and paid for at the TVID office BEFORE
September 20th

The Tualatin Valley Irrigation District (Supplier) and

_____ (Consumer) recite:

1. Supplier operates an irrigation water service.
2. Consumer desires and will beneficially use irrigation water service for commercial and/or suburban agricultural purposes on the following acreage(s):

Pipeline Turn-out	River Diversion	October \$50.00	November \$50.00	Total Amount Due

3. Subject to all the same policies, terms, and conditions for furnishing water service to members during the regular irrigation season, May 1 to September 30 of each year. Consumer has read and understood supplier will provide extended service for the acres described above. This subscription is for one season only. **THE DISTRICT DOES NOT ASSUME ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR FAILURE TO MAKE DELIVERIES OR FOR DAMAGE THAT MIGHT OCCUR FROM FREEZE.** The extended water service will be at the sole discretion of Supplier.
4. Extended/Late season is available for the months of October and November. Consumer shall pre-pay a service charge of **\$50.00** per turnout box or per river diversion per month, plus any excess over one foot per acre charge. There will be a \$100.00 charge to turn on a box that has been shut down and winterized. Consumer agrees to pre-pay all other costs including mapping, filing, extra O&M and administrative charges that may be necessary as a result of the extended season.
5. Consumer assumes liability for freeze damage and shall hold harmless, indemnify and defend Supplier from all claims and awards arising from his use of said water service.
