Tualatin Valley Irrigation District Seeking Candidates for Board Vacancy

Tualatin Valley Irrigation District (TVID) is accepting applications to fill one open position on its board of directors. You are receiving this notice because you have lands with assessed TVID acres within TVID Division 1.

The appointee will serve the remainder of the Division 1 term, which expires December 31, 2028. TVID had been previously recruiting candidates for a special election to fill the position. TVID received no petitions by the February 3, 2026 deadline. The position is now vacant.

The TVID Board of Directors is comprised of five board members. Each member is elected by the registered voters of the district to serve a 3-year term. The current vacancy may be filled by appointment by a majority vote of the remaining board. **Applicants for the vacant position must be the owner of the land, or have ownership interest in the corporate entity that owns the land, subject to district charges and assessments. The land must be situated within Division 1.**

The vacancy will remain open until filled by appointment by a majority vote of the remaining members of the board, or until a future election date.
