### **Tualatin Valley Irrigation District Seeking Candidates for Board Vacancy**

Tualatin Valley Irrigation District (TVID) is accepting applications to fill one open position on its board of directors. Eligible candidates must meet the requirements set forth in ORS 545.043. In short, applicants for the vacant position must be the owner of the land, or have ownership interest in the corporate entity that owns the land, subject to district charges and assessments. The land must be situated within District 1.

The TVID Board of Directors is comprised of a five-member board. Each member is elected by the registered voters of the district to serve a 3-year term. Director Joe Finegan resigned from the board effective October 14, 2025. Given that Finegan resigned during the standard election process, the position will be filled via a Special Election on March 10, 2026. The elected board member will serve in the District 1 position until the term expires in December 2028.
